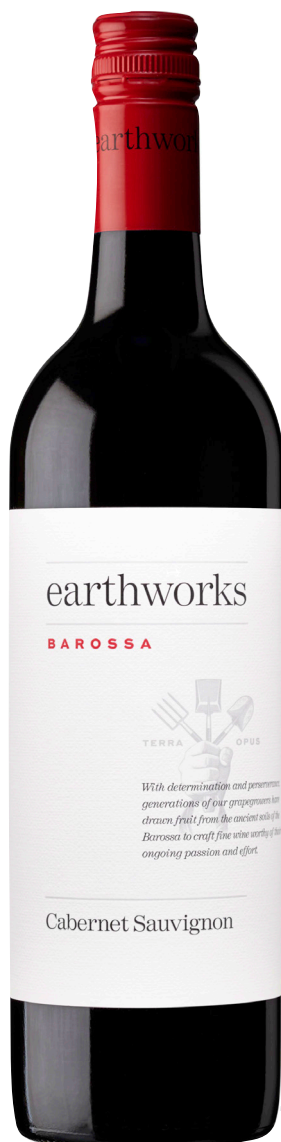

## 2016 Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon

*Family owned and operated, Barossa earthworks make its wines from 100% Barossa grapes, grown at small family owned vineyards.*

*Drawing on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing are used to preserve the purity, integrity, texture and flavour of the wines.*



### Winemaker's Notes

Deep ruby red in colour. Warm and enticing berry aromas frame a picture of mocha chocolate, sun ripened plums, cassis and rosemary. Round, soft and generous, the flavours lead with summer plum and berry compote, vanilla and boysenberry. Hints of mocha chocolate complement the velvet finish. This is a wine with broad shoulders and a straight back, akin to the character of our loyal Barossa growers.

### Vintage Information

Our vineyards across the Barossa experienced a cold winter with lower rainfall. Dry and warm conditions, particularly before Christmas 2015 resulted in a vintage that was two weeks earlier than average. These dry and warm conditions meant the vineyards were able to ripen the grapes seamlessly, producing an abundance of flavour.
