earthworks draws on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal intervention to preserve wine quality and integrity.

Winemaker's Notes

Bright ruby, purple in colour. Warm, enticing blueberry aromas with mocha chocolate, cedar spice, plums and cassis. Big, soft and generous, the palate displays plum and berry compote, toasted vanilla and boysenberry. Hints of mocha chocolate complement the rich, velvety finish.

Enjoy with homemade saltbush lamb sausage rolls, or cherry tomato and tapenade tartlets.

Vintage Information

A long, cold and slightly drier Barossa winter that warmed in spring, allowing the vines to produce healthy canopies and a good crop. Typical summer warmth and minimal rainfall allowed the grapes to ripen, and resulted in wines of great flavour.
