Barossa Shiraz 2018

Family owned and operated, earthworks make its wines from 100% Barossa grapes, grown from small family owned vineyards.

Drawing on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing are used to preserve the purity, integrity, and flavour of the wines.

Winemaker's Notes

Vibrant ruby red with crimson and magenta hues. Aromas of dark berry and satsuma plum cleverly supported with spicy mocha, liquorice, vanilla, and pepper. The hints of boysenberry and strawberry all converge to allow your senses to take you on a flavourful journey. A polished and voluptuous wine with a soft, round flourish of dark fruit. The aromas are mirrored by the flavours on the palate with dark chocolate undertones and silky tannins in the background.

Vintage Information

The Barossa experienced a long and cold but slightly drier Winter through mid-2017. The weather eventually warmed in Spring and with that the vines set a healthy crop and good canopies. Typical Summer warmth and minimal rainfall followed to ripen the grapes. Harvest progressed with great flavours allowing for spectacular wines in tank. Look out for the fine 2018 vintage in bottle, rewarding and renowned.
