Winemaker's Notes

Vibrant ruby in colour with crimson and magenta hues. Aromas of dark berries and plum with liquorice, vanilla and pepper. The aromas are mirrored on the palate with dark chocolate undertones and silky tannins.

Enjoy with sticky barbecue beef ribs, silken tofu with chilli bean paste or spicy cinnamon and rhubarb bake.

Vintage Information

A long, cold and slightly drier winter that warmed to a mild spring. This mild, dry weather through the growing season produced grapes with great flavour and concentration. Typical summer warmth and minimal rainfall allowed the grapes to ripen, and resulted in spectacular wines of rich and robust flavour.
