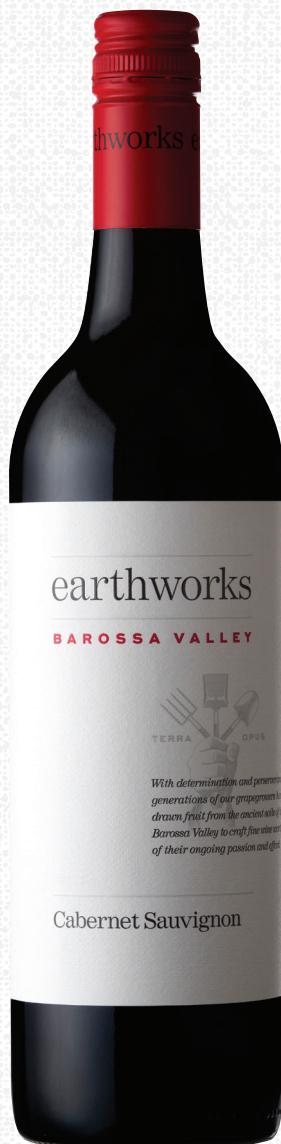

2013 Barossa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

Family owned and operated, Barossa earthworks make its wines from 100% Barossa grapes, grown at small family owned vineyards.

Drawing on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing are used to preserve the purity, integrity, texture and flavour of the wines.



Winemaker's Notes

A deep blood red colour with generous Barossa Valley aromas from a fine vintage: vanilla, blueberry, cherry ripe, violet, smoky oak and toasted almond.

The palate is round, soft and generous, the flavours lead with plum jam, vanilla and boysenberry. Hints of toast and dark chocolate complement the finish, which is full and generous, just like our Barossa growers.

Vintage Information

Warm and dry conditions prevailed for most of the 2012/13 growing season. Our Barossa grape farmers, using their years of experience were able to manage their vineyards to produce small yields of highly flavoured grapes, reflected in the 2013 vintage Cabernet Sauvignon.
