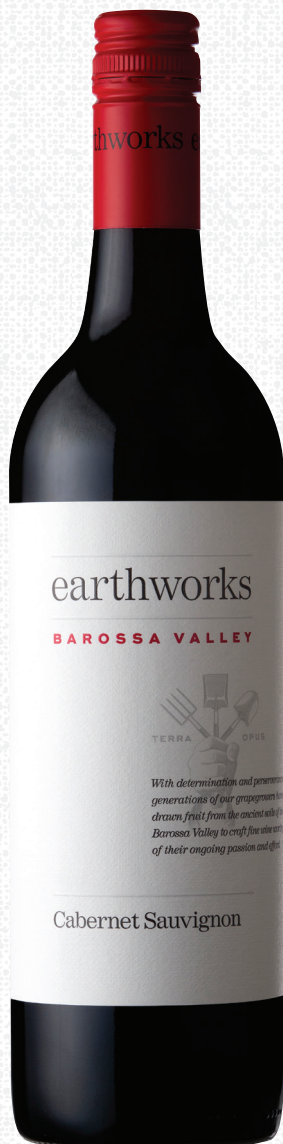

2014 Barossa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

Family owned and operated, Barossa earthworks make its wines from 100% Barossa grapes, grown at small family owned vineyards.

Drawing on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing are used to preserve the purity, integrity, texture and flavour of the wines.



Winemaker's Notes

Deep blood red in colour. Enticing aromas from an outstanding Barossa vintage fill the glass: vanilla, blueberry, cherry ripe, violet, tar and toasted almonds.

Round, soft and generous, the flavours lead with plum jam, vanilla and boysenberry, while hints of toast and dark chocolate compliment the finish. This is a wine with broad shoulders and a straight back, akin to the character of our loyal Barossa growers.

Vintage Information

The winter and spring rains replenished the soils and set the vines up for a successful growing season. January was hot and windy, yet the vines were refreshed by mid-February showers which allowed the Cabernet Sauvignon grapes to ripen slowly through March.
