Family owned and operated, earthworks make its wines from 100% Barossa grapes, grown from small family owned vineyards.

Drawing on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing are used to preserve the purity, integrity, and flavour of the wines.



Winemaker's Notes

Deep crimson in colour with generous aromas of boysenberry, blood plums, tar, coffee and vanilla.

A medium bodied wine with a soft round flourish of fruit. The aromas are mirrored by the flavours on the palate that also have dark chocolate undertones. The tannins are supple, smooth and generous, just like the characters of the region.

Vintage Information

The winter and spring rains of 2013 replenished the soils and set up the vines for a successful growing season. Soils, site and viticultural practises vary considerably but the one common factor in these vineyards is the unmistakable generosity that shines through in the wine.
