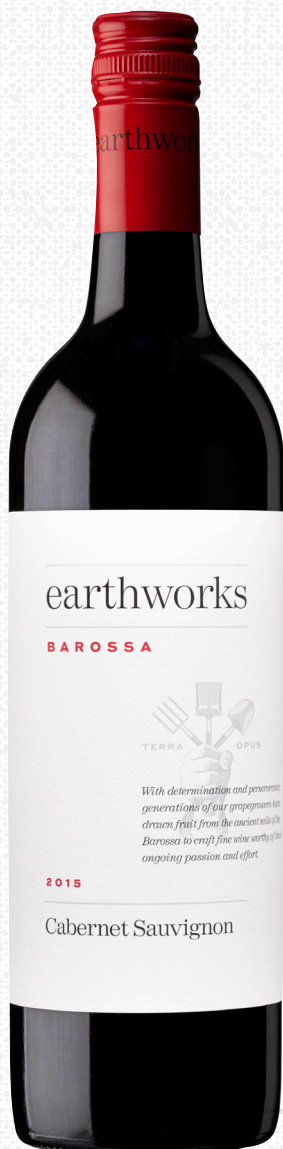

2015 Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon

Family owned and operated, Barossa earthworks make its wines from 100% Barossa grapes, grown at small family owned vineyards.

Drawing on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing are used to preserve the purity, integrity, texture and flavour of the wines.



Winemaker's Notes

Deep blood red in colour. Warm and enticing aromas frame a picture of mocha chocolate, stewed blood plums, cassis and rosemary goodness. The palate is round, soft and generous, the flavours lead with summer berry compote, vanilla and boysenberry. Hints of mocha chocolate compliment the velvet finish. This is a wine with broad shoulders and a straight back, akin to the character of our loyal Barossa growers.

Vintage Information

A very mild summer, followed by warm and dry conditions during February, meant that the grapes for Earthworks Cabernet Sauvignon ripened early and rapidly. Luckily our loyal growers know their vineyards well and we were able to pick these Cabernet grapes in perfect condition.
