Family owned and operated, earthworks make its wines from 100% Barossa grapes, grown from small family owned vineyards.

Drawing on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing are used to preserve the purity, integrity, and flavour of the wines.



Winemaker's Notes

Vibrant purple with crimson hues. Aromas resembling a compote of dark berries and satsuma plums cleverly supported with mocha, vanilla, and black pepper accents. You might see hints of boysenberry and strawberry, depending on where your senses take you. A polished and voluptuous wine with a soft, round flourish of fresh fruit. The aromas are mirrored by the flavours on the palate which also has dark chocolate undertones. Silky tannins are present only in the background.

Vintage Information

A very mild summer, followed by warm and dry conditions during February, meant that the grapes for Earthworks Shiraz ripened early and rapidly. Luckily our loyal growers know their vineyards well and we were able to pick these Shiraz grapes in perfect conditions.
