WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Dark ruby and magenta in colour. Aromas of oaky vanilla, blackberry and plum compote lead into hints of biscuit dough, star anise, chocolate cake and warm spice.

On the palate, the wine is decadent and rewarding with sticky chocolate, plum and soft, generous tannins.

VINTAGE INFORMATION

A long, cold, slightly drier winter. The weather warmed in spring with the vines setting a lighter crop and good canopies. Summer warmth and minimal rainfall followed to ripen the grapes with great flavours at harvest.
