WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The wine reveals deep garnet and ruby hues. A nose of coffee grounds, cocoa powder, sage bush and brambled blueberry gives way to violets, smoked white spice, roasted coconut and cigar box.

On the palate the wine has fruit sweetness wrapped around long chalky tannins with touches of moreish olive tapenade to finish.

VINTAGE INFORMATION

A typical cold Barossa winter, flowed into a wet spring and cool growing season. Harvest across our Barossa vineyards was about 2 to 4 weeks later than we had experienced over the last decade. Fine and clear weather during the harvest period and patience by the winemaker made for excellent flavour and tannin accumulation in our Shiraz and structure in our Cabernet Sauvignon.
