WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The wine reveals deep garnet and ruby hues. Aromas of ground coffee, cocoa powder, sage and blueberry give way to violets, smoked white spice, toasted coconut and cigar box.

On the palate, the wine has fruit sweetness wrapped around long, chalky tannins with touches of moreish olive tapenade to finish.

VINTAGE INFORMATION

The Barossa experienced a long, cold and slightly drier winter through mid-2018. The weather warmed to a mild spring and with that the vines set a lighter crop and good canopies. Typical summer warmth and minimal rainfall followed to ripen the grapes.

Harvest progressed with great flavours resulting in spectacular wines.
