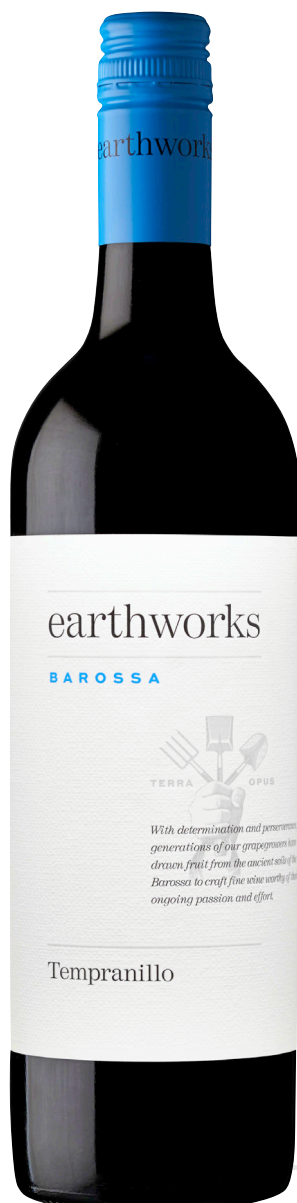

Family owned and operated, earthworks make its wines from 100% Barossa grapes, grown from small family owned vineyards.

Drawing on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing are used to preserve the purity, integrity, and flavour of the wines.



Winemaker's Notes

Deep crimson in colour, there are aromas of plum, mulberry, Worcestershire sauce and black pepper on the nose. An enticing palate reminiscent of black forest cake; layers of plush chocolate and black cherries in liqueur. The finish is extremely long with cocoa powder tannins.

Vintage Information

A warm and dry spring gave the growing season an early start. Warm and dry weather continued until the end of January when an inch of rain fell, giving the vines the drink they needed to finish ripening the grapes. The warm days during summer and autumn were mediated by cool nights, leading to great fruit flavours being exhibited in this Tempranillo.
