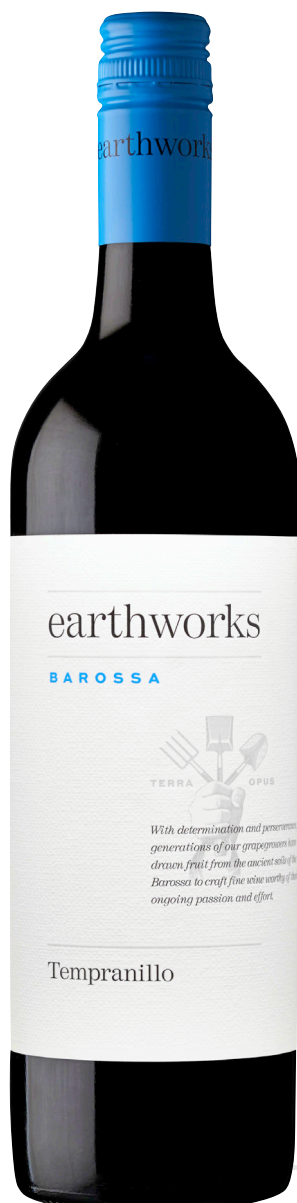

Family owned and operated, earthworks make its wines from 100% Barossa grapes, grown from small family owned vineyards.

Drawing on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing are used to preserve the purity, integrity, and flavour of the wines.



Winemaker's Notes

Scarlet red in colour, with attractive aromas of boysenberry, black pepper and black forest cake. A plush and juicy wine with layers of chocolate, liquorice and pomegranate, finishing with cocoa powder tannins.

Vintage Information

The growing season started with a wet winter and spring, supplying plenty of available water in the root zone for the vines to access. Spring and early summer temperatures were mild and below average, resulting in a long and even ripening period. These ideal conditions for grape growing allowed us to make optimal picking decisions. The warm and dry days during late summer and autumn, combined with cool nights, have produced immaculate fruit for the 2017 Tempranillo.
