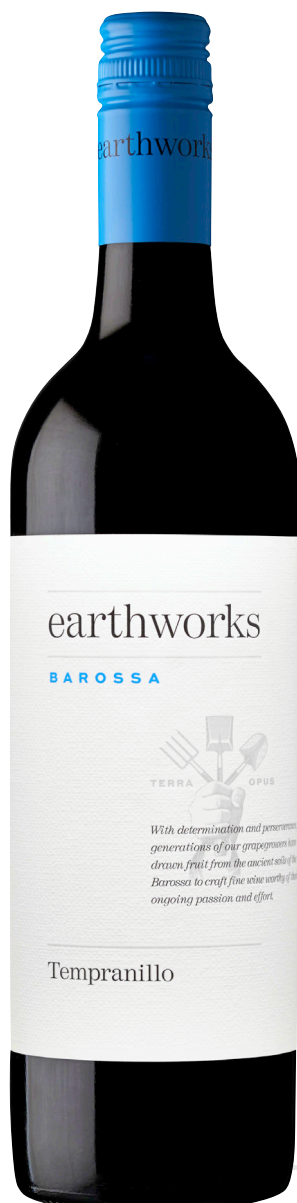

Drawing on more than 160 years of local wine knowledge, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing are used to preserve the purity, integrity, and flavour of the wines.



Winemaker's Notes

Blood red in colour, Earthworks Tempranillo opens with boysenberry, pepper, a hint of charred meats and black forest cake aromas. The soft tannins spread over your palate giving a juicy, ferrous, velvet mouth feel.

Vintage Information

A very mild summer followed by warm and dry conditions during February meant that the grapes for Earthworks Tempranillo ripened early and rapidly. Luckily our loyal growers know their vineyards well and we were able to pick these Tempranillo grapes in perfect condition.
