Winemaker's Notes

Deep red in colour with purple hues. A dark and brooding wine, full of blackcurrant pastille, boysenberry and chocolate coated liquorice aromas. The palate is rich and luxurious, with loads of brambly black berries and a fine tannin finish.

Enjoy with charcoal grilled T-bone and sweet potato wedges or baba ganoush with toasted pita crisps.

Vintage Information

Good winter and spring rains set the vines up for a great growing season. The vines consequently grew very healthy canopies. As January arrived, so did the warm, dry weather bringing on ripening. We achieved great flavours in the grapes that have resulted in a wine full of vibrancy and varietal character.
